North American Dog Agility Trials

The North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC) Trials will be held at CAM-PLEX in Barn 3 May 1-3, 8-10, 15-17 & 22-24, 2009. That is 4 full weekends of Agility Trials! Competition will begin at 9:00 am and run until around 6:00 pm. Admission is FREE to the viewing public. Over 150 competitors will be here to run the agility courses vying for the championship qualifications to run in September in Tennessee!

NADAC was formed in 1993 to provide all breeds of dogs (including mixed breeds) and their handlers a fast, safe and enjoyable form of the sport of dog agility. NADAC Trials demonstrate the ability of the dog and handler to work as a smoothly functioning team in completing different obstacle courses. The courses consist of jumps, tunnels, weave poles, dog walks, etc. in fun, fast and challenging sequences.
