

RULES FOR JESUS LITTLE LEVI RODEO

1. Contestant's age limits are as follows: **PEEWEE 9** years and under, **JUNIORS 10-13**, **SENIORS 14-17**. You must enter division by **age as of the day of the rodeo**. No crossing over age divisions.
2. Check in will begin Saturday at 7:30 AM. **IF NOT CHECKED IN BY 8:45 CONTESTANT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE**, contestants must be **in the bleachers for church at 9:00A.M.**
3. A contestant may enter each event only once.
4. Western dress is required; hats are optional in the arena (NOT REQUIRED). No ball caps or visors in the arena.

No entry will be accepted without the release form 100% complete. Both parents HAVE to sign and must include both names on the notary line. NO EXCEPTIONS. Read last paragraph on release for specific instructions.

PEEWEE Barrels and Poles: Contestants assisted will be assessed a 10 second penalty.

Barrel Racing: 3 barrels, placed according to arena dimensions. Cloverleaf pattern must be run. Barrels tipped over result in a 5-second penalty. Broken pattern is a **NO TIME**.

Pole Bending: 6 poles, approximately 21 feet apart. Poles tipped over will result in a 5-second penalty. Broken pattern is a **NO TIME**.

Goat Tying: Tie any 3 legs; goat must stay tied down for 5-seconds. After turning loose of string to call for time, touching goat again without permission of the flagger will result in a **NO TIME**: 60 second time limit. **Junior and Senior division will be horse back for goat tying.**

PEEWEE Ribbon Snatching: Start behind the line on foot. Contestant must run and grab the ribbon off the goat's tail and run back across starting line for a time. The **whole** ribbon must be off the goat's tail to receive a time.

Steer Riding: 1 or 2 hands, 6-second rides will be scored by judges. Any rides under 6 seconds will be timed for the length of the ride, placing accordingly. **NO SUICIDE WRAPS.**

Steer Riding – Senior Division: **LIVESTOCK WILL BE YEARLINGS.** 1 hand, 6-second rides will be scored by judges. Any rides under 6 seconds will be timed for length of the ride, placing accordingly. **NO SUICIDE WRAPS.**

Mutton Busting: 1 or 2 hands, 6 second rides will be scored by judges. Any rides under 6 seconds will be timed for the length of the ride, placing accordingly. **no ropes may be used.**

Breakaway Roping: 3 legal head catches (straight horns, ½ head, and neck) 2 loop limit, you may rebuild once, 60 second time limit. Flagged as rope breaks away from saddle horn. Must turn loose of rope and not place it on steer.

Dummy Roping: 3 legal head catches (straight horns, ½ head, and neck). Ropers start behind the line, (**no time for crossing over the line**) time stops when slack is pulled tight. 2 loop limit. Must swing loop at least once and turn loose of rope.

Senior Dally Team Roping: 3 legal head catches (straight horns, ½ head, and neck). 5 second penalty for one foot. 60 second time limit. 3 loop limit per team. Header and heeler must dally, face and come tight. (**HEADERS MUST BE DALLYED AND TURNED OFF BEFORE THE STEER ENTERS THE CATCH PEN**) **Figure 8's and front leg automatic no time, no crossfires. If fouled**, must pull up and declare yourself. Any entries without a named partner will be placed with one by us.

Family Relay Surprise Race: A 3-member team. Team must include 1 parent and 2 rodeo participants. (Must be a parent to at least one of your participant team members, participants can be from any age division.) The event will require 1 horse. Any misses or broken pattern will result in a 5-second penalty per violation. Entry fee is \$5.00 per rodeo participant, parents are free.
