National High School Finals Rodeo

July 17-23, 2011

Preparations are well underway for the "World's Largest Rodeo" to return to Gillette in July. This year marks the 63rd Anniversary of the NHSFR. Contestants and their families travel to Gillette from 41 states, 5 Canadian provinces, and Australia. CAM-PLEX Multi-Event Facilities is proud to host this event for the 9th time. As many of you know, this mammoth event involves our whole community on one level or another. Over 6,000 people including competitors, their families, and trade show exhibitors, will descend on Gillette for an experience of a lifetime. The student athletes have spent the year vying for the honor to compete in the Finals. The top four qualifiers from each of the thirteen rodeo events are invited to compete in the NHSFR. Contestants will compete for college scholarships and cash awards. The economic impact of this event on our community is an estimated five to seven million dollar increase in revenue. CAM-PLEX Rodeo committees and staff will be calling on the support of hundreds of local people and businesses as the event draws near.
